club. Although, those who chose FFA are quite special. Freshman year, FFA is offered to you for the first time ever and some may or may not know what FFA is all about, but they still get involved.

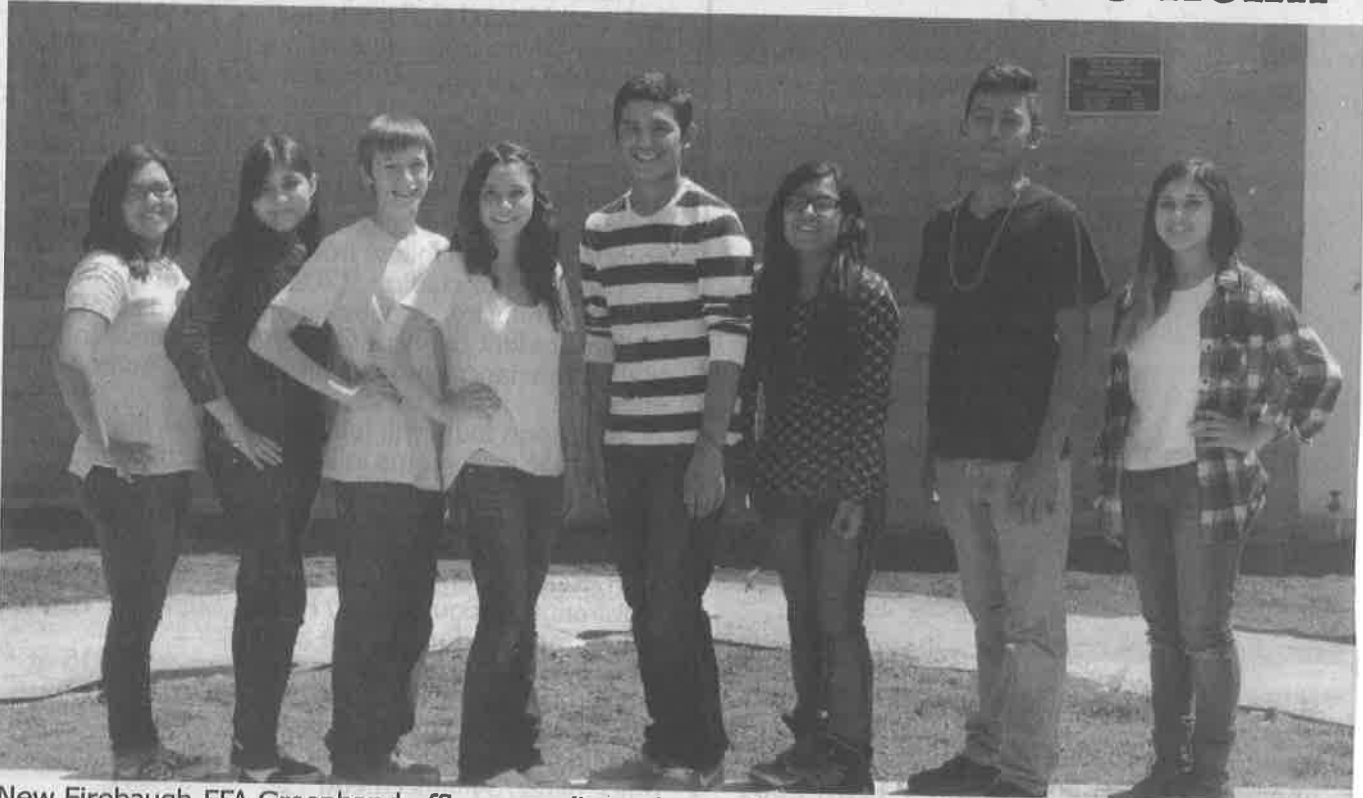
